## Accepted Digital Files

**All aspect ratios are 4:3 and the video must be delivered deinterlaced.**

Here are the recommended settings for your original video:

<b>MPEG-4</b>	640 pixels by 480 pixels	1.5 - 3.0 Mbps	Demuxed** 192 Kbps, 48 kHz or above	30 fps
<b>H.264</b>	640 pixels by 480 pixels	1.5 - 3.0 Mbps	Demuxed** 192 Kbps, 48 kHz or above	30 fps

<b>AVI</b>	640 pixels by 480 pixels	At least 750 Kbps, and up to 1-2 Mbps or more	Demuxed** 64 Kbps, 44 kHz, stereo or above	24 fps (inverse telecined) or 30 fps (video)

\* = Preferred format for best results

\*\* = Demultiplexing (or demuxing) is where the video and audio are independent elementary streams within a MPEG or AVI file. Muxed audio is combined with the video stream.
